Crossroads is a new LDT cycle (composed for TIEMF 2025), and now exists in two versions: a fragmented, open-form version with possible contributions from other LDT sequences (installation version), and a concert version, a continuous journey lasting more than 40 minutes and comprising four sequences: Memory Hall, Improvisation 1, Algorithm 711 and Morphélectrosuite. The LDT's computer programs generated sound material in real time, creating a new trajectory, a memory that is definitively fixed here, but remains open to interpretation. In the first Memory Hall sequence, this memory comes up against a continuum, an impassable space close to a "saturation" of space-time, the superposition of sound universes having reached a perceptible limit. Like a dialogue with the machine, Improvisation 1 and Morphélectrosuite "freely" counterpoint this algorithmic invention, itself echoed in Algorithm 711.

Two video installations (creations) complete this Crossroads cycle: *Come Out from Within* and *Pixel 7*.

BIOGRAPHY

Stéphane de Gérando (June 23, 1965) is a French contemporary artist and researcher. He earned the highest degrees in France, both in composition at the Conservatoire de Paris (postgraduate) and as a university researcher (habilitation to supervise research), studies supplemented by the computer music program at IRCAM. He is particularly interested in the role of algorithms in the development of the imagination, with a comprehensive understanding of the work of art in the 21st century. A former director of higher education programs linked to the French Ministry of Culture, Stéphane de Gérando is currently head of the electroacoustic composition department at the CRR d'Amiens in France. He is also the artistic director of an international creative week.

Works: More than 130 pieces, from solo instruments to orchestras with or without electronics, algorithmic digital installations, monumental projections, virtual tableaux, polyartistic creations in theater, dance, music, digital technologies, virtual and augmented reality.
